

We honor Betsy Chadderdon Frantz for her lifetime of service and contributions to The University of Texas at Austin and UTHealth in Houston.

Betsy's leadership includes a memorable role in The University's "We're Texas" \$1.6 billion campaign, the first public university billion-dollar comprehensive campaign in the nation. The campaign funded the construction of the Jack S. Blanton Museum of Art, the Edgar A. Smith Building, and many other campus projects and programs benefiting students and faculty.

Her effervescent spirit and unwavering sense of purpose draw people to her everywhere she is involved. Betsy's energy and focus propelled her career as a trailblazer, leading the first Committee on the Status of Women at UTHealth Houston—the first such committee in the UT System (1970s). She continued this advocacy throughout her career, serving as the landmark first female president of the Texas Exes Houston Chapter.

Betsy co-chaired her 50-year reunion in Austin in 2015, recently accepted a position on the UT Foundation Board, and has been selected for the UT M.D. Anderson Patient and Family Advisor Program.
